# RRO Domain – CEDRO in WP3

- CEDRO
  - ▣ 20 years history – knowledge of business & special cases
  - ▣ Consolidated repositories and systems
  - ▣ Participant in first Arrow project – already integrated
  
- Add RRO point of view to the project
  - ▣ Try to anticipate problems and needs + particular situations
  - ▣ Define needs in terms of systems.

# RRO Domain – Save costs

- RROs integrating in ARROW. Two main situations
  - ▣ Already existing RROs, with systems in place
    - Integrate in Arrow as participants in first project
      - Develop WS and modules on top of existing systems
  - ▣ New players, RROs with no systems / repositories
    - Save costs – define & create core reusable system
      - Avoid proprietary situations

## RRO Domain - HOW

- Provide context and knowledge of RRO role in ARROW + Gather requisites, cases, national peculiarities...
- ▣ Preparation and distribution of guidelines and questionnaire
  - 24 participants – 10 responses
- ▣ Analysis, discussion and elaboration of requisites
  - Document available for incorporation in deliverable 3.1

# RRO basic system – Main features

- Architecture
  - ▣ Web
  - ▣ Customizable + extendable
  - ▣ Decentralised Db and server location - @RRO
- Functionality (under study)
  - ▣ Multilingual
  - ▣ Handle RRO information needed to interact with Arrow
    - Parties, persons and institutions, mandates, uses, right holders, manifestations
  - ▣ Import, export, search, order, statistics & quality, logs, ...
  - ▣ Customizable WF to respond Arrow

# RRO domain – Next steps

- Functional analysis
  - ▣ Data model definition
  - ▣ Detail functionalities & scope
  - ▣ Study customizable ARROW management module

Feedback is a must !!
- Technical analysis
  - ▣ Select technical platform (.net vs java, dbms, ...)
- Maintenance model – life cycle definition
  - ▣ Customize vs extensions. Documentation.
- Development & testing
