Management strategy

- Run a central and up-to-date documentation site for WP7 allowing partners to be quickly informed about the status quo of the work package

Key objectives and expected results

- Set up a thorough Validation roadmap
- Different validation scenarios (simple, middle, advanced)
- Achieve a detailed and exhaustive validation report for each country involved
- Carry out a case study on the ROW by using a bunch of digitised dissertations (mainly from Germany and Austria)

Key steps/milestones



- M10: an overview of all involved countries
- M15: Validation roadmap
- M20: First result of Validation activities
- M30: Validation report

Main criticalities

- The situation is very different in each countries
- The variety of languages used in the project
- No support from national library in validation activities (as it was in ARROW)

Connection with other WPs

- WP7:
 - ▣ is the leader in the validation process.
- WP3:
 - ▣ National contact point for Austria
 - ▣ Contact and coordinate with other national working groups in view of the validation of new registries.
- WP4:
 - ▣ Monitor the new system developments, with the purpose of design new validation tools.
 - ▣ Support the testing activities

 - ▣ information about the involved countries
 - ▣ support in the validation process (to create ground truth)
- From WP4
 - ▣ the actual status quo of the ARROW system and ROWs
